Hello MLA Sections,

Similar to the MLA Annual meetings of 2008 and 2010, the Section Council is planning to hold a Section Shuffle for MLA 2012 on Sunday May 20 from 6-7pm.

The previous events have been a great success and a fun way for MLA members to learn more about participating in our sections. If you haven't seen it, here is a short video highlighting the 2010 event.

http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=wX7GB4_5h3E While exact attendance numbers aren't available, we would estimate that around 400 people were in attendance.

The plans for the 2012 Section Shuffle include beverages, refreshments and a competition for the most innovative and fun Section Table theme/decoration. The Section Shuffle will also include forms for people to use to sign up for 6 month trials to Sections they are new to or haven't been a member of for 5 years. In 2010, 350 people signed up to join sections during the section shuffle as compared to only 79 that signed up for a trial membership at the Section Council Booth last year.

Unfortunately, MLA is unable to assist the Section Council in funding this event. In addition, requests for seeking vendor funding have been denied. This means that it's more important than ever that we receive funding from all sections to ensure that this event is a success. Only sections that submit a pledge form will be eligible to participate in this event. Attached is a pledge form for your section to contribute to this event. We need to hear back from everyone by mid-March, 2012. Your contributions will ensure that next year's event is an even bigger success than the last one. Using the menu prices from 2011, the Section Shuffle Taskforce estimates that we would be able to provide 350 people with: 8oz of coffee or lemonade, one hors d'oeuvre, and one pastry for around \$4500. We used this data to come up with our recommended pledges on the attached form.

Also, start brainstorming with ideas for your Section Table theme. You might consider using the conference's theme of "Growing Opportunities: Changing Our Game," you might also think of creative ways to highlight what your section represents in terms of interests. Or, just do something completely different (Twilight theme? Mad Men? Fish Market? The sky's the limit!) The winning section will be recognized during a general business meeting, get press in MLA News on MLA Social Media sites, receive a trophy icon for their website and live on in glory in conference goers memories from that day forward.

Attached is the Section Pledge form mentioned earlier for being invoiced.

To support the Section Shuffle, section officers can simply authorize their section treasurer to pay the donation amount via the centralized account payable system administered by MLA.
