Hi Diane,

Yes, I think this is one of the areas where the Research Section, i.e., RS mentoring program, can and should provide expertise and mentoring support/coordination. Like a number of other types of research mentoring, this area would benefit from our expertise and mentoring support. I really like this area because it does have a narrow focus with deadlines...it might be a good place to start in our more general efforts (RS & MLA Research Task Force) to enhance research mentoring within RS and across MLA.

I have a couple more thoughts about this...

First relating to the MLA Research Task Force itself: This area should definitely be added to the list of "research expertise" areas on the MLA mentoring website so people can be aware that this type of mentoring is offered...also on our RS website...and also we could have a link on the Research Project/Demonstration grant site (Kris' idea).

Presently the mentor expertise area of "grant writing" appears under 'Administration' on the MLA mentoring website which is confusing. So I have a question for you and everyone. How would this specific mentoring support (MLA grant & application mentoring) differ from "grant writing" mentoring support in general? Does our section want to be involved with "grant writing" mentoring in general or just as it relates to MLA projects/grants? Once we decide on a general or specific approach to providing research grants support, we would need to clarify this with MLA and also on the MLA website.

Just FYI, the MLA Research Task Force is working on updating and creating a new list of 'research mentoring' categories...when the draft of this new updated list of research mentor categories is ready we will be share it with all of you for your comments...Heather Holmes and I

(who currently serve on the MLA Research TF and who are currently working on this list) will send it to everyone in several weeks.

Finally, we presently have very few research mentors...I did a quick search on the MLA membership directory for "grant writing" mentors and there are 23 MLA members who say they would serve as grant mentors but most are not members of the Research Section. I am not certain whether these 'mentors' would actually serve as research mentors if asked. If we move forward on this initiative we would need to identify and recruit more members (most likely a combination of RS and MLA members) who would be willing to serve as research mentors for MLA projects & grants. And I do have several ideas for recruiting/targeting more researchers to serve as research mentors which would be useful to this process.

Hope these comments are helpful. Sorry for my delayed response.

Presently the mentor expertise area of "grant writing" appears under 'Administration' on the MLA mentoring website which is confusing.? So I have a question for you and everyone. How would this specific mentoring support (MLA grant & application mentoring) differ from "grant writing" mentoring support in general? Does our section want to be involved with "grant writing" mentoring in general or just as it relates to MLA projects/grants? Once we decide on a general or specific approach to providing research grants support, we would need to clarify this with MLA and also on the MLA website.

Just FYI, the MLA Research Task Force is working on updating and creating a new list of 'research mentoring' categories...when the draft of this new updated list of research mentor categories is ready we will be share it with all of you for your comments...Heather Holmes and I (who currently serve on the MLA Research TF and who are currently working on this list) will send it to everyone in several weeks.

Finally, we presently have very few research mentors...I did a quick search on the MLA membership directory for "grant writing" mentors and there are 23 MLA members who say they would serve as grant mentors but most are not members of the Research Section. I am not certain whether these 'mentors' would actually serve as research mentors if asked. If we move forward on this initiative we would need to identify and recruit more members (most likely a combination of RS and MLA members) who would be willing to serve as research mentors for MLA projects & grants. And I do have

several ideas for recruiting/targeting more researchers to serve as research mentors which would be useful to this process.

Hope these comments are helpful. Sorry for my delayed response.
