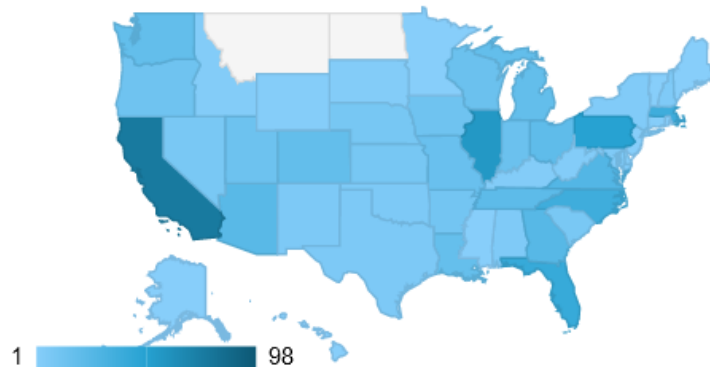
Participation Rate



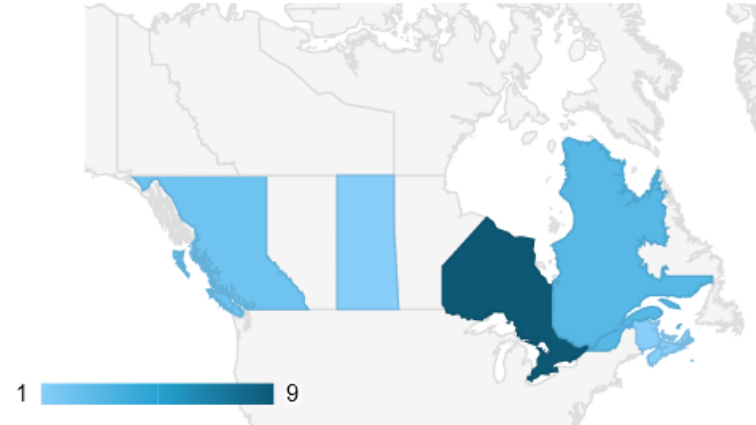

User States



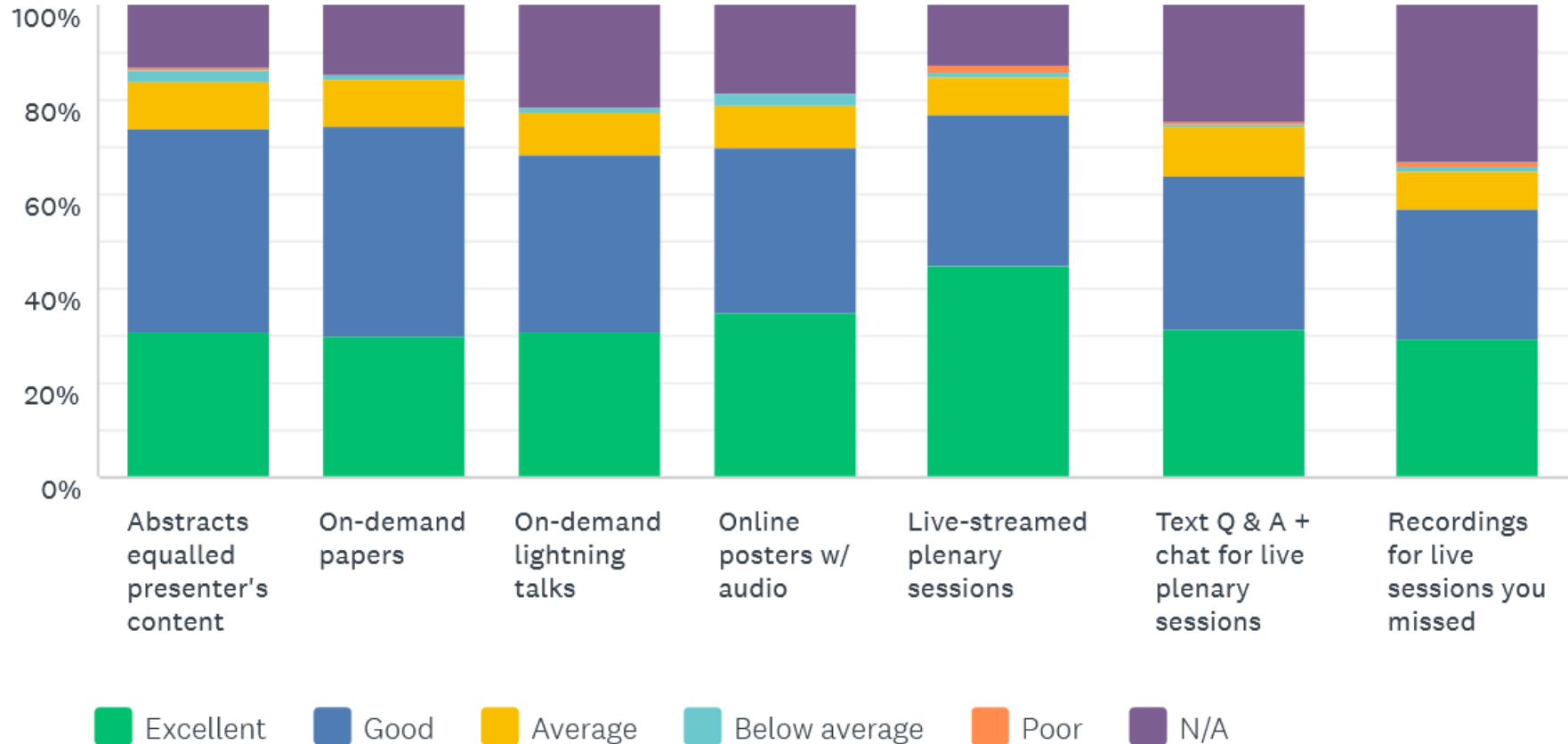

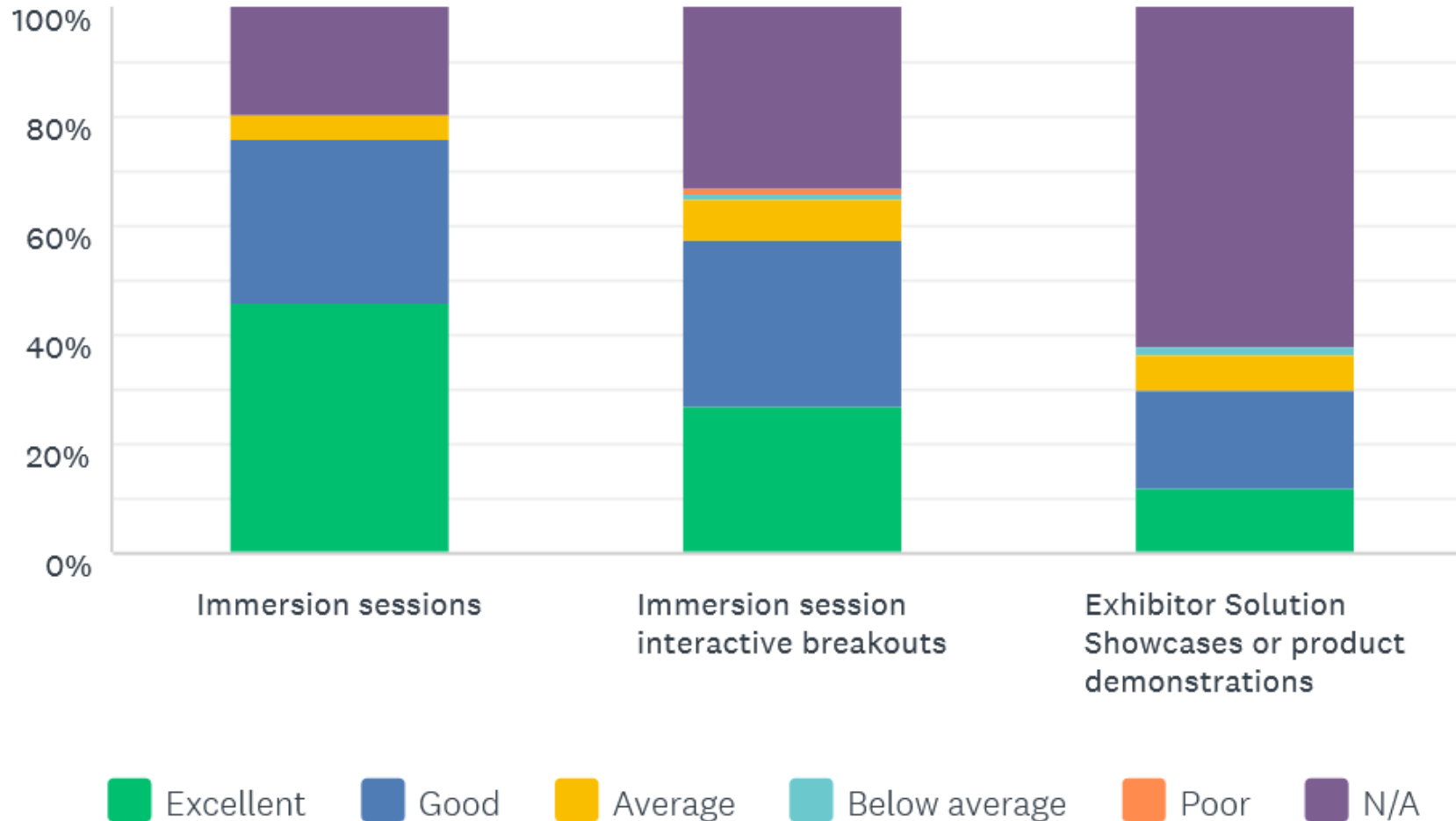

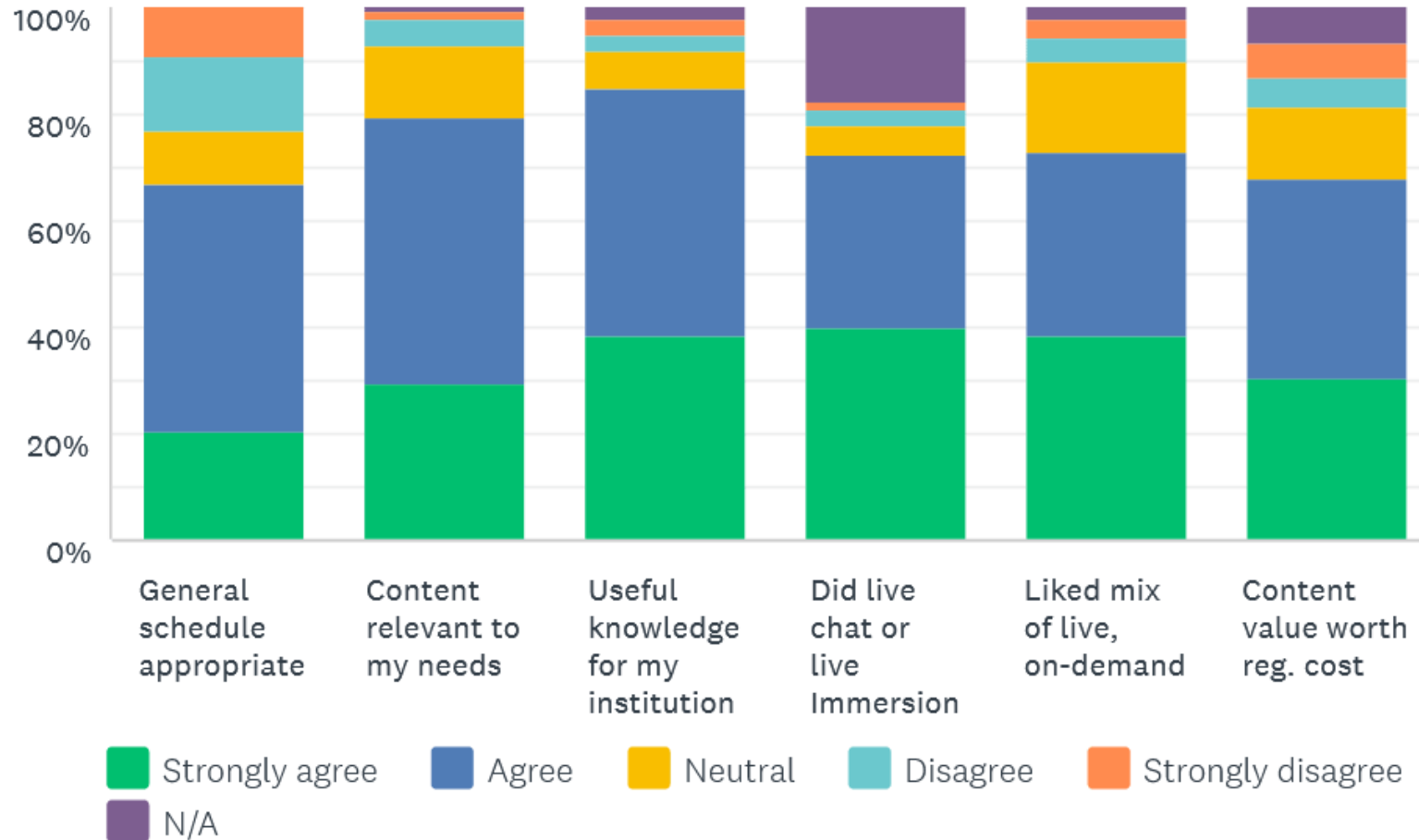

The mix of on demand content and live interaction and engagement [worked well]. Please, please keep this going forward, to provide accessibility to all of us, not just those of us who can afford and can physically travel to an in-person conference.
